Take them a Meal is a meal coordinating service for someone that may be receiving meals from different people in a relatively short period of time. It was created for use in events like surgery, a severe illness, hospitalization, or a death in the family. It allows anyone that receives the link to see what has been signed up to be sent or delivered to the recipient so they don't end up with 3 buckets of KFC on the same date or 5 days in a row of pizza. Using this system does NOT mean you have to order from them. It was intended only for coordination.
