INTRODUCTION TO THE PASSION PASSION OF JESUS ACCORDING TO ST. MARK 14:1-15:47

The passion story in Mark's gospel presents Jesus as one who dies abandoned by all. He shows himself to be the true Son of God by giving his life for those who have forsaken him.

Jesus is anointed.

Jesus and his disciples share their last Passover together.

Communion

We will receive The Lord's Supper by intinction with two stations. The Pastor and the Assistant will distribute the host (bread), which will then be dipped in either the silver chalice (wine) or the gold chalice (grape juice).
