Fellowship Committee: The annual Epiphany Chili Cook Off will be held today in the fellowship hall after the congregational meeting.

Also, our first Lenten Soup & Sandwich supper will be on Wednesday, February 25th @ 6 p.m. with a devotional service starting at 7 p.m. The Music Ministry will be the chefs for the evening. Come, join us!

Hunger Walk/Run: Save the date and join us for the annual Hunger Walk/Run on March 15th at the Home Depot Backyard in Atlanta at noon. We will carpool from the church and eat lunch before we go. You can register online to walk with us (\$30 is the minimum and you will also get a t-shirt) or just donate to our team. Our goal this year is \$1,000. You can donate on the website, through Vanco or write a check made out to Epiphany and designate it to the Hunger Walk. More info to follow.

Social Ministry: Once again, we are collecting donations (cans of soup or chili or money) for our annual participation in the Souper Bowl of Caring (Super Bowl Feb. 8). The Souper Bowl of Caring was started in 1990 and since then has raised over \$220 million for local food charities across the country. All of our proceeds go directly to Rockdale Emergency Relief. Please leave your donations on the table in the narthex or give a financial donation and mark your envelope accordingly.

In addition to the Souper Bowl donations, we are also collecting other food items for the month of February to include -- canned vegetables, cereal, peanut butter and jelly. Collection bins will be in the Narthex. As always, thanks for your generous support.
