Sunday Morning Adult Forum: *What is the Church Called to Be? A Study in Titus:* During the month of August, the adult class continues its study of the Pastoral Letters of Paul (1 Timothy to Titus) at 9 a.m. in rooms 7-9. “In Titus, Paul gives directives to his co-worker Titus who now ministers in Crete. How might these directives speak to the church today?”

Starting on September 6, come join us as we discover how the book Song of Solomon may speak to us in our faith journeys today. Maybe you did not know that this small book existed in the Bible. And the few verses you may have heard from the book were used at weddings, celebrating the love between a couple. On the surface the book is a love poem between a man and a woman. Yet, the early church read within its words a description of our intimate relationship with God that we grow into within our lives.

Women’s Bible Study: The Women’s Bible Study is studying the many stories of unnamed characters throughout scripture; from the Woman at the Well to the Queen of Sheba, from the Ethiopian Eunuch to the Penitent Thief.
